KUHN focuses on feeding versatility at Dairy Day

KUHN Farm Machinery will highlight the versatility of its PROFILE trailed TMR mixers and the extensive options available to buyers to suit any type of system of farm setup.

The company will have two PROFILE machines on display – a PROFILE 22.2 CM and a PROFILE PLUS 15.1 DL. These two models are now complimented by the latest PROFILE 1.CM, which was introduced to the range in July. Rhodri Jenkins, KUHN's grassland and feeding product specialist, says the discharge and mixing configurations available across the range will suit all types of users.

"On the stand is the PROFILE 22.2, which is a medium sized machine with a cross conveyor, while the 15.1 has a large hopper and direct feed side doors. Buyers require versatility and efficiency when mixing and discharging, and these models show how bespoke they can be. The PROFILE Plus 15.1 has KUHN's straw blower fitted in front of the hopper to allow bedding and feeding from the same machine. This saves time, money and increases the productivity of daily tasks."

Buyers in the market for a trailed straw blower will be interested in KUHN's PRIMOR 5570 M, with the established POLYDRIVE system. The 5.5m³ model has recently been joined by the PRIMOR GII 110.1 Polydrive, which retains the low overall height and single feed rotor for high, consistent throughput of material, in a compact design.

KUHN's UK bedding and feeding product specialists will be on hand to meet new and existing customers and the stand will also feature a Multi-Longer 5757 hedgecutter, and RW 1610 round bale wrapper, with the e-Twin pre-stretch wrapping technology. Finally, the FB 3130 round baler will also be at the show on KUHN's stand, E30. This model now features the TWIN-reel film binding option, offering a higher pre-stetch ratio on the 750mm rolls than competitors, helping to reduce film binding costs by 37%.
